A Tree for Everybody.

Oswestry Town Council has set a target to plant **one tree for every inhabitant of Oswestry**. These 17,000 new trees will help us reduce the impacts of climate change and promote biodiversity. Are our Local Health Services Good Enough?

The Health authority has spent a small fortune consulting on the location of A+E services, but this does nothing to improve services in Oswestry. When Shropshire's Director of Public Health was invited by one of your Green Councillors to come to Oswestry, she revealed the alarming statistic that people living in Shrewsbury have, on average **several more years of healthy life** than people in Oswestry. We need to know why this is and what we can do to improve things.



Time to Spend a Penny or Two?

The Town Council took over the running of the toilets on Central Car-Park several years ago. We recently renovated the toilets in Cae Glas park and these are now looking very good. Some people say we need to upgrade these ones as well, but we don't want to waste money unnecessarily and these works will be quite expensive. So, if you have used these toilets **let us know what you think** of them.

The Case of the Disappearing Bridge.

Back in March 2019 the Shropshire Star reported that money had been set aside for a footbridge as part of the £10M Mile End road improvements. However no footbridge was included in the plans they put out to consultation in the Autumn. We say that it simply won't be safe to get to the new employment park on the other side of the A5 by foot or by bicycle without a bridge or tunnel, so we are **continuing to lobby Shropshire Council** to deliver it.
